



Private, cultural, heritage & immersive local experience

Duration: 7 Days / 6 Nights

Destination: Delhi – Agra – Jaipur

This journey offers an introduction to the rich history, colourful culture and everyday life of India. Along with visiting some of the country's most famous monuments, the journey also allows you to experience India beyond the usual tourist attractions.

The tour combines the historic cities of **Delhi, Agra and Jaipur** with an authentic rural experience near Jaipur, where you will have the opportunity to meet local people, visit agricultural fields and understand traditional farming practices. You will also visit a local government primary school, subject to prior permission, to gain an insight into education and community life in rural Rajasthan.

DAY 01 | ARRIVAL IN DELHI

Upon arrival at Delhi International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by our representative and assisted with your private transfer to the hotel.

After check-in, the rest of the day will be kept relaxed so that you can settle into your hotel and recover from your journey.

Depending on your arrival time, you may enjoy a gentle evening walk around the local area or experience some of Delhi's local food and atmosphere.

DAY 02 – Delhi

Discover the History of Old & New Delhi

After breakfast, begin your full-day exploration of Delhi, a city where centuries of history exist alongside modern India.

Start with **Old Delhi**, where you will explore the historic lanes and vibrant markets around **Jama Masjid and Chandni Chowk**. A short **cycle-rickshaw** ride through the old city offers a wonderful way to experience the lively atmosphere, traditional shops and everyday life of Delhi.



Continue your sightseeing with some of Delhi's important historical landmarks, including **Humayun's Tomb** and the magnificent **Qutub Minar**.

You will also drive through the ceremonial areas of New Delhi and see landmarks such as **India Gate** and the important government buildings.

The day provides an interesting contrast between the old and new sides of India's capital city.

DAY 03 - DELHI – AGRA

The Mughal Heritage of Agra

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and proceed by private vehicle to Agra.

Upon arrival, check in at your hotel and take some time to relax.

In the afternoon, visit the impressive **Agra Fort**, a magnificent Mughal fortress built largely in red sandstone. The fort offers beautiful views towards the Taj Mahal and provides an insight into the lifestyle and history of the **Mughal emperors**.

Later, explore some of the local areas and markets of Agra. You may also have the opportunity to learn about the city's famous traditional handicrafts and marble inlay work.

Agra is not only home to the Taj Mahal but also a living city with a strong artistic and craft tradition.

DAY 04 - AGRA – JAIPUR

Taj Mahal at Sunrise & Journey to the Pink City

Rise early this morning for one of the highlights of your journey — a **sunrise visit to the Taj Mahal**.

As the first light of the day touches the white marble, the monument takes on beautiful changing shades. Your guide will introduce you to the fascinating history and story behind this world-famous monument.

Return to the hotel for breakfast and check out.

Continue your journey by private vehicle towards Jaipur, the colourful capital of Rajasthan.



En route, you may visit **Fatehpur Sikri**, the historic Mughal city known for its impressive architecture and palaces.

On arrival in Jaipur, check in at your hotel and enjoy some time at leisure.

DAY 05 - JAIPUR

The Royal Heritage of the Pink City

After breakfast, begin your exploration of Jaipur, famous for its royal palaces, magnificent forts, colourful bazaars and distinctive pink architecture.

Begin with a visit to the spectacular **Amber Fort**, located on the hills outside Jaipur. Explore its grand courtyards, palaces and beautiful architectural details while learning about the royal history of Rajasthan.

In the afternoon, visit the **City Palace**, which reflects the royal heritage of Jaipur, followed by **Jantar Mantar**, the historic astronomical observatory.

Later, visit **Hawa Mahal**, one of Jaipur's most recognisable landmarks.

The evening can be spent exploring the colourful local bazaars, where you may see traditional textiles, handicrafts, jewellery and other products associated with Rajasthan.

DAY 06 – JAIPUR – SAMODE

A Day in Rural Rajasthan | Farming, Village Life & Local Community

After breakfast, depart from Jaipur by private vehicle for **Samode**, a charming rural area located approximately 40 km from Jaipur. Today is designed to offer an authentic experience of Rajasthan beyond its forts and palaces, giving you an opportunity to discover the countryside and meet the people who live and work here.

On arrival in the Samode area, begin your **Rural Rajasthan Experience**. Travel through the countryside and agricultural areas, where you can observe the landscape, traditional village houses and the daily rhythm of rural life.

Local Village Experience



During the visit, you may enjoy a simple interaction with local families over traditional tea or refreshments and learn more about everyday life in rural Rajasthan.

This experience provides a chance to see a different side of India — one that is often missed on conventional sightseeing tours.

Visit to a Local Government Primary School

Later, subject to **prior permission from the school authorities**, you will visit a local government primary school.

The visit will provide an opportunity to understand how a local school functions, meet teachers and learn about the educational environment of children in a rural community.

After the visit, return to Jaipur.
